- Further develop the skills and knowledge of the staff and management committee around inclusion
- Developing an ongoing dialogue with all members of the club around the areas of diversity and inclusion, in order to overcome any potential anxieties or prejudices and to enhance the welcoming, open atmosphere of the club.
- Provide positive role models.
- Maintaining and developing links with and obtain support and information from appropriate agencies
- Treating all children equally whilst respecting their individual needs and abilities
- Responding to children's diverse needs and working in partnership with Parents/Carers and children
- Providing age appropriate activities that cater for all abilities
- Discussing with Parents and Carers ways of meeting their needs
- Ensuring that all staff and volunteers are made aware of the needs of children who attend the club
- Providing resources and a social and physical environment which promotes optimum involvement, enjoyment and independence for all children
